- Should ideally come from existing plans and strategies...have the advantage of being already approved...
- Proposals could be identified from a variety of sources...
- National Development Plan Chapter 3...
- Range of existing plans in each Gateway...LUTS..statutory development plans...
- Strategies for Docklands...city centre regeneration strategies...strategic development frameworks...
- Proposals need to build into a package that demonstrates added value...

## **Developing the proposal...**

- Lead authorities nominated...
- What is GIF about: encouraging collaboration/coordination...
- Collaborative approach to preparation of GIF proposal is essential....
  - Involvement of all local authorities
  - Role for wider regional perspective Regional Authorities
  - Role for wider private and community sectors
  - Gateways with existing arrangements build on these...

(1): Assembling Team

(2): Study of GIF Terms

(3): Review of existing plans

(4): Options - consultation

(5): Business case/CBA

(6): Proposal Formulation


(7) Assessment - Government

- Access to expert advice...(CBA)


#### **Consultation very important...**

- Consult with Chambers of Commerce..IBEC...CIF...local entrepreneurs...
- Regional Interests...
- Liaise with Regional Authorities...
- Use of existing mechanisms...co-ordination teams etc

## Successful Proposals will...

- Clearly create <u>added value</u> through synergies and complementarity....(NDP, private investment stimulated, good fit of elements...)
- Be integrated within longer term co-ordination proposals...GIF cannot be the end of the story...
- Stand up robustly to critical business-case evaluation...
- Be implementable easily and quickly with effective project management arrangements...
- Work forward from existing planning frameworksdevelopment plans, LUTS's, regeneration strategies...
